**Third Grade Math St. Patrick's Day Word Problems, CCSS.Math.Content.3.OA.A.3**



**You are bringing shamrock cookies to your class St. Patrick's Day Party. You have a recipe that will make 12 cookies, but there are 30 kids in your class.**

**How much should you multiply 12 by to get 30 or more cookies? \_\_\_\_\_**

**Great! Now you know that you need to multiply everything in your recipe by 3.**

Sugar Cookie Recipe

You will need:

2 eggs

1 cup of flour

½ cup of sugar

**Eggs:  $2 \times 3 =$  \_\_\_\_\_**

**Flour:  $1 \times 3 =$  \_\_\_\_\_**

**Sugar:  $\frac{1}{2} \times 3 =$  \_\_\_\_\_**
